

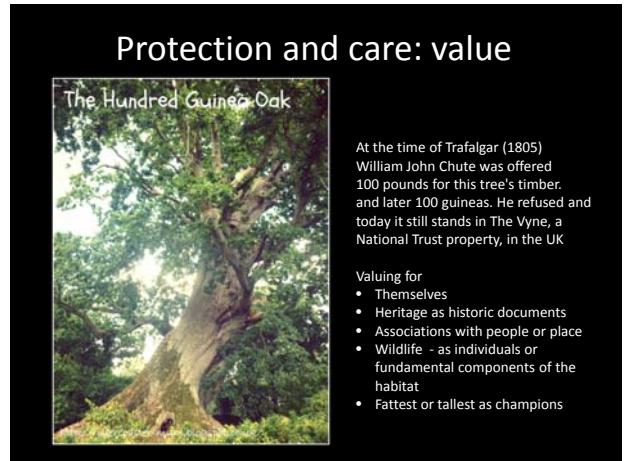

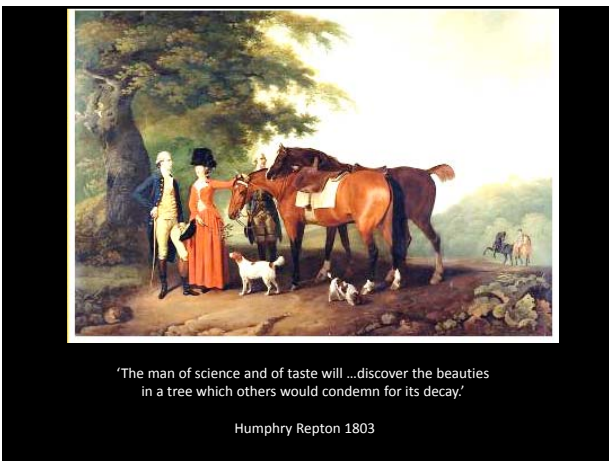
Protection and care: value



The Hundred Guinea Oak

At the time of Trafalgar (1805) William John Chute was offered 100 pounds for this tree's timber, and later 100 guineas. He refused and today it still stands in The Vyne, a National Trust property, in the UK
